



## Florida Governor Imposes New Rules After Nursing Home Deaths

### *Short Deadline for Energy Upgrades*

Yesterday Florida Gov. Rick Scott responded to Hurricanes Harvey and Irma's unimaginable damage and destruction, as well as loss of life with new regulations for all of the state's assisted-living facilities and nursing homes (link to New York Times article [here](#)).

Under the new rules, owners will have 60 days to obtain what the governor's statement called "ample resources" that will "sustain operations and maintain comfortable temperatures" for at least four days after a power failure. Those resources include a generator and fuel.
