### Green Generation Solutions secures \$979,688 in Rebates and Incentives

*GreenGen receives Energy Efficiency Grants from the Maryland Energy Administration's EmPOWER Maryland Commercial & Industrial Grant Program*

BETHESDA, MD (June 5, 2014) – Green Generation Solutions, LLC announced that it has secured \$979,688 in energy efficiency incentives for five projects in Maryland. The Maryland Energy Administration (MEA) is providing \$595,000 of the funding to implement ambitious upgrades to commercial, institutional, and industrial buildings. In conjunction with the MEA funding, GreenGen secured an additional \$384,668 in utility rebates from Pepco and BGE for the five projects.

The energy efficiency Commercial and Industrial Grants from MEA show Maryland's leadership in ensuring the state's energy future," said Brad Dockser, CEO of GreenGen.

As part of the EmPOWER Maryland, the MEA Commercial & Industrial Grant Program provides competitive grant awards to privately-owned commercial and industrial buildings that reduce electricity usage by 20 percent or more. To encourage the deepest possible energy savings, awards will cover up to 50% of project costs after other incentives have been applied. MEA awarded \$4 million in overall funding. GreenGen's five clients represent 25% of the grant recipients. The award of \$595,000 represents the largest allocation of grant funds to any energy solutions provider.

Facility upgrades funded by the grants include the following:

- Installation of interior and exterior LED lighting and control systems
- Installation of advanced high-efficiency controls and web-based BMS for packaged RTUs
- Installation of occupancy-based hotel guestroom and HVAC controls
- High efficiency HVAC equipment replacements
